

## BASEBALL PROGRAMS

### HOUSE LEAGUE - BOYS & GIRLS

The House League Program is all about recreational baseball - focusing on skill and personal development and stressing participation for all. Teams play other Martingrove teams and at some levels interlock with local leagues. Martingrove offers continuous play from May to August/September ending with playoffs. Players receive medals or trophies for participation. The commitment is a minimum of one game and one practice per week. Players must provide their own helmet and glove.

### SELECT/REP BASEBALL - BOYS & GIRLS

For those players who are interested in playing more baseball, we offer Select and Rep Baseball. These teams and players represent MARTINGROVE BASEBALL Inc. against surrounding GTA and Ontario teams.

Games are played throughout the week. Participation in weekend tournaments is also required to keep the competitive edge. The season starts in early September with tryouts, and continues with a winter program and spring training - all in preparation for the coming season. The Select commitment is 2 practices and 2 games per week. **All Rookieball (9U), Mosquito (10U/11U) and Peewee (12U/13U) must play both Select and House League. Every player must attend all games and practices for both Select and House League or they can be removed from the Select team.**

For both Select and Rep, the registration fees shown are paid to the league to cover costs; including, but not limited to, equipment, baseballs, permits, insurance, team and individual photos. Players and parents are responsible for additional costs such as tournament entry fees and related transportation and/or accommodation, uniforms, training and umpires.

### BLASTBALL - BOYS & GIRLS

Blastball provides an ideal entry level of play for the youngster who will go on to other advanced levels of the game. It is geared to boys and girls aged 4 and 5 years old. Blastball is meant to put FUN back into the game of baseball. It is designed to generate fast paced action, provide recreation and exercise, create enthusiasm and encourage children to continue to play the game. This program teaches all five basic fundamentals of baseball - hitting, throwing, catching, running and fielding. Blastball plays June to the end of August.
